


WP: World Premiere NYP: New York City Premiere AP: American Premiere

Playwrights Preview Production 1984, the original name for Urban Stages, opened its door to four one-acts: two by known playwrights, Arthur Kopit (NYP) and Leonard Melfi (WP), along with a play by Frances Hill The Park Bench (WP) and On the Rocks (WP) by Joanne Tedesco directed by Paul Dervis
